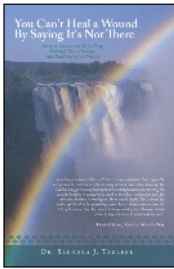


You Can't Heal a Wound By Saying It's Not There

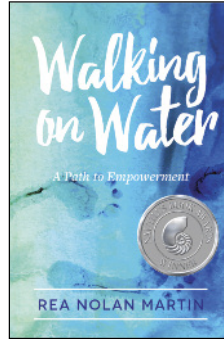

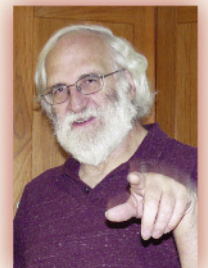
